Note to Parents:

Bible Reading for the Day: Matthew 14:22-33

- Have your child grab a Bible, have a seat, and look up the passage that is going to be read for the day
- Focus on helping your child look up Scripture and help them remember the order of the books of the Bible. If they are at reading age, have them read the passage.
- If you don't have a Bible at home, you can go to this link to the text on Bible Gateway

Questions about Matthew 14:22-33:

Note: If you are unsure of the answers to these questions, you are encouraged to re-watch today's video lesson or reread the passage

For Elementary-age kids:

- What is a miracle? (click <u>here</u> for answer)
- What miracle did Jesus perform in today's story?
- In what ways did Peter show faith in Jesus?
- In what ways did we see Peter fail to show faith in Jesus?
- Was Peter forgiven of his failures?
- We show our faith in God by obeying Him and not sinning against Him. Where have you failed to trust God?
- How can you repent of that sin and choose to trust Him? (for definition of repent click here)

For Pre-K kids:

- What miracle did Jesus perform in today's story?
- How did Peter show his trust in Jesus?
- Jesus predicts Peter will deny him 3 times before the rooster crows. This prediction comes true when Peter tells people he did not know Jesus. Was this showing trust in Jesus?
- Was Peter forgiven of his failures?
- When we choose to obey God, we are choosing to trust God. Think of some times where you haven't trusted God.
- How can you repent of that sin and choose to trust God instead? f(or definition of repent click <u>here</u>)

Activity:

ROLL OUT THE WATER:



Roll out a LONG sheet of paper on a table and let children draw waves with blue markers on the lower half of the paper. Draw a boat, Peter, and Jesus and tell the story again while the children draw pictures as the story is told. Write the Bible verse in the waves.

Big Picture Question:

Practice asking your child today's Big Picture Question and have them respond with the following answer:

Parent: Do Christians always have perfect faith?Child: No! But Jesus extends His perfect grace!
