- What do you think Jesus meant that He was only sent "to the lost sheep of the house of Israel?"

- What was it about the Canaanite woman that made Jesus decide to heal her daughter?
- What was different between the Canaanite woman in this passage and the Pharisees mentioned in verses 1-20?

Big Picture Question:

Practice asking your child today's Big Picture Question and have them respond with the following answer:

Parent: Can we ever be "good enough" for God?

Child: No! But God's grace extends to those who trust in Him!
