- What is the "leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees" Jesus was referring to?
- When is it easy for you to get distracted from the gospel of Jesus and focus more on other things in this world?

Big Picture Question:

Practice asking your child today's Big Picture Question and have them respond with the following answer:

Parent: What truth does Jesus want us to focus on?

Child: That He will save us if we trust and follow Him!
