- Why were they upset when they relieved their pay?
- Did the master have the right to pay the workers who weren't there the whole day the same amount as the ones who did?
- What is Jesus trying to teach us about God and His kingdom in this parable?

Big Picture Question:

Practice asking your child today's Big Picture Question and have them respond with the following answer:

Parent: Is God fair?

Child: No, but He is gracious!
