PRAYER IS THE FUEL FOR MISSION

Memory Verse:

Colossians 4:6 Let your speech always be gracious, seasoned with salt, so that you may know how you ought to answer each person.

1) CATCH UP ON LIFE

This is when we update each other on the day in and day out happenings of our lives. Because God is our Father we are family. As church family, we care about each other's lives: what we're celebrating, what we're mourning, what decisions we are praying through, and everything in between. (1 Thessalonians 2:8, Romans 12:10 and 15)

Celebrate the wins - where have you seen Jesus working in the last week (shaping you to be more like Himself or working in the lives of those that He's put around you)?

What (if any) big life updates do you need to catch us up on (positive or negative)? Are there any practical needs you have right now?

Pray: Take every opportunity to pray and thank God for the good He's doing in our lives, and ask for help and healing anywhere there is pain.

2) REVIEW THE MISSION

Through the empowerment of the Holy Spirit we have been sent as missionaries in everyday life to display God's glory and lead others to repentance and faith through belief in the gospel. (John 20:21 and 2 Corinthians 5:18-20)

We are each going to take some time to make a mission field map and then pray over our current mission opportunities.

1) Take some time to fill out the Mission Field Map sheet in order for us to consider and evaluate our current mission opportunities and efforts.

Choose your best opportunity for mission - this could be work, school, sports league, family, etc. Then fill in the following information:

4. Have you ever hung out with them outside of your normal settings?5. Have you ever had a spiritual conversation with them or shared the gospel with them?

2) *Plan:* What is your best avenue for taking your next step with each person on your list? What is a possible avenue for us to join together as a group in connecting with those around you?

3) Pray: Prayer is the fuel of God's mission. Let's pray for our people by name; pray for their needs, and opportunities to have spiritual conversations that help them take next steps toward Jesus.
